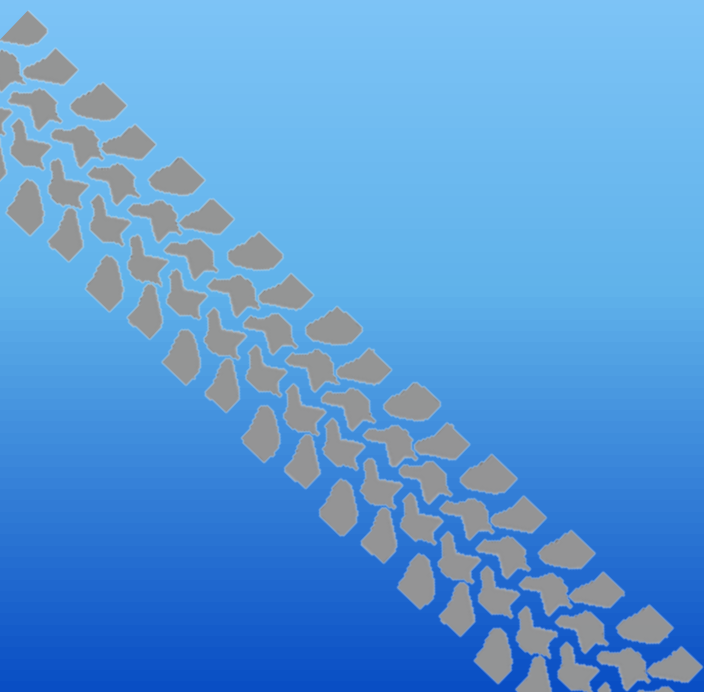

- Fixed recent bug: Gallery list was only listing those with video content, no photos only galleries. It got broken with the 2020-01-23 changes



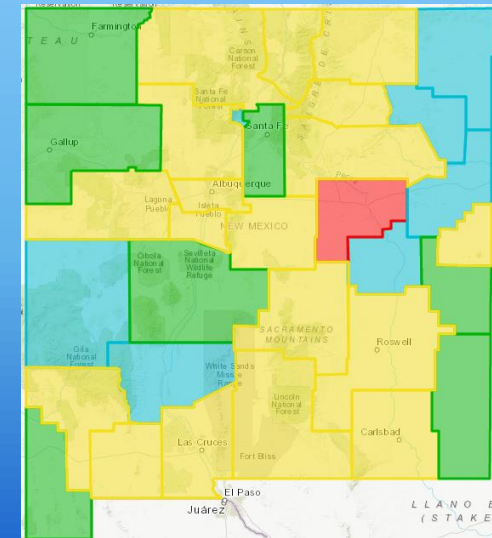
